Incident/Investigative Activity

At approximately 1330, Wednesday, 10SEP03, FBI Sacramento, CA contacted NCISRA Jacksonville, Fl. in reference to obtaining a command authorization for search and seizure of S/YEE's personal affects to include: notebooks, lap top computer; PDA or palm devices; notes; papers; or any electronic media storage devices containing information or documents that have been unlawfully obtained from Ahmad Al Halabi or detainees from Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Violations are to include but not limited to, violation of the UCMJ, Art. 81 (conspiracy); Art. 92 (orders violations); Art 106 (spying); and Art 106a (espionage).

[REDACTED] contacted NAS Jacksonville, FL SJA Lt. Andrew Massucco, USNR and a conference call was placed to FBI Sacramento, CA. After communication with the FBI, and the U.S. attorney's Office Lt Massucco briefed the CO of NAS Jacksonville, Fl., Captain Mark S. Boensel, USN. At 1600 Capt Boensel signed the command order for search and seizure and [REDACTED] hand delivered a copy to [REDACTED] at the Nas Jacksonville Air terminal.

[REDACTED] conducted a search of S/YEE's person and property. Items seized were Islamic books, documents, a cell phone, a roll of film, a Government Compaq computer, Government keys, receipts, a passport, and VHS media tapes. These items were seized temporarily and will be forwarded back to Army Intelligence in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba per their request.

At 1800, [REDACTED] was notified by LTCol Michael Boehman, SJA GITMO, that Brigadier General James E. Payne, CO, JTF GITMO, wanted S/YEE confined in the NAS Jacksonville, FL Brig. At 1819 a confinement order was forwarded to NCISRA Jacksonville, Fl. This order was presented to S/YEE and two base security officers took S/YEE into custody. S/YEE was taken to the base hospital for a physical and then taken to the brig for confinement.
